In a study of the periodical cicada (*Magicalicada septendecim*), researchers measured the hind tibia lengths of the shed skins of 110 individuals. Results for males and females are shown in the accompanying table.

We want to test to see if the average tibia length of male cicadas is larger than that of female cicadas. Calculate the power of the test to detect a difference where the average male tibia length is 2 micrometers larger than that of females.
